- "Live as people who are free, not using your freedom as a cover-up for evil, but living as servants of God. Honor everyone. Love the brotherhood. Fear God..." 1 Peter 2:16-17.
- We will humbly submit to the decisions and instructions of the leaders (1 Peter 2:13-14, Col. 3:22), respecting the schedule and standards set for the camp without complaints/grumbling (Phil. 2:14).
- We will make sure that our relationships reflect purity in attitude, dress, and actions (ex: no disrespectful talk, fighting, no guys in girls' cabins/bathrooms and vice-versa, etc.) (1 Tim. 5:1b-2, 2 Tim. 2:22).
- We will concentrate on listening to godly, Christian music, taking a break from the other things (movies, secular music, etc.).
- We will respect and pay for any damages to camp property.
- We will not leave the campgrounds or skip any activities unless permission is granted.
- We will make sure not to have any alcohol, tobacco, or any other illegal substances with us at camp.
- We will not bring any sort of weapons [Ex: any type of guns (including paint ball guns), knives, slingshots or any ninja-type weapons].
- Cell phone use is permitted only during free time.
- Pranks or jokes advocating character or attitude are not permissible under any circumstance [(Ex: (Phil. 4:8)].

## Camp Rules (Page 2)

- 1) All campers must adhere and obey the camp rules.
  - Failure to do so will result in a one-on-one meeting with the leaders and proper steps will be taken from there.
  - If camper's behavior becomes a constant issue at camp and problem for others, the camper who is exhibiting this behavior will be sent home immediately.
  
- 2) All campers must attend the camp activities that are planned out for the entire group (announcements will be made as to which these activities are).
  - If camper is sick or injured, he/she may be excused from participating in an activity.
  - A camper may refuse to participate in a particular activity if there are options available to choose from.
  - Those are the only two reasons a camper can miss an activity such as small groups or chapel, and a camper must notify a leader first if they will be missing.
  
- 3) Both RBYA rules and Camp Calvin Crest rules are to be upheld by both leaders and campers.
  - Failure to obey any of these rules will result in either a camp punishment or a one-on-one meeting with the leaders to decide upon a solution
  - Failure to comply with rules/leaders in order to change the problem will result in suspension from camp of the camper

Guest Group Activities  
Participant Agreement, Release and Acknowledgement of Risk**

In consideration of the services of, their agents, owners, officers, volunteers, participants, employees, and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on their own behalf (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Calvin Crest"), I hereby agree to release and discharge Calvin Crest Conferences, on behalf of myself, my children, my parents, my heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate as follows:

1. I acknowledge that my participation in Calvin Crest activities including but not limited to challenge, initiative, recreational boats, climbing wall, ropes course, pool, flume, zip line and giant swing entails known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death, or damage to myself, to property, or to third parties. I understand that such risks simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. **In addition to the risks already stated, other risks include but are not limited to:** Calvin Crest programs are based on the "challenge by choice" principle. At any time you and/or your group are free to withdraw from participation in challenge, initiative, or climbing and their potential for slips, falls, and falling, rope burns, pinches, scrapes, twists, and jolts that could result in scratches, bruises, sprains, lacerations, fractures, concussions, or even more severe life threatening hazards. During an activity, there may be contact with plants, animals, or insects that could create hazards such as stings, allergies, and associated disease. Calvin Crest facilitators are concerned with safety of participants, but they may not be aware of a participant's fitness or ability, and may not be able to accurately predict all weather conditions.
2. I expressly agree and promise to accept and assume all risks existing in the activity. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary, and I elect to participate in spite of the risks.
3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and to hold harmless Calvin Crest from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action, which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity or my use of Calvin Crest's equipment or facilities, including any such claims which allege negligent acts or omissions by Calvin Crest.
4. Should Calvin Crest or anyone acting on their behalf, be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.
5. I certify that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may cause or suffer while participating, or else I agree to **bear the costs of such injury** or damage to myself. I further certify that I have no medical or physical conditions which could interfere with my safety in this activity, or else I am willing to assume – and bear the costs of – all risks that may be created directly or indirectly, by any such condition.
6. I understand and agree that all terms of this agreement release and acknowledgement shall be governed by California Law.

By signing this document, I acknowledge that if anyone is hurt or property is damaged during my participation in this activity, I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against Calvin Crest on the basis of any claim from which I have released the organization herein.
