## **Camp Rules** (Page 1)

These expectations are based on Scripture and are here to keep us focused on the Lord, help us in edifying each other, keep our witness above reproach, and help us have a good time.

- "Live as people who are free, not using your freedom as a cover-up for evil, but living as servants of God. Honor everyone. Love the brotherhood. Fear God..." 1 Peter 2:16-17.
- We will humbly submit to the decisions and instructions of the leaders (1 Peter 2:13-14, Col. 3:22), respecting the schedule and standards set for the camp without complaints/grumbling (Phil. 2:14).
- We will make sure that our relationships reflect purity in attitude, dress, and actions (ex: no disrespectful talk, fighting, no guys in girls' cabins/bathrooms and vice-versa, etc.) (1 Tim. 5:1b-2, 2 Tim. 2:22).
- We will concentrate on listening to godly, Christian music and take a break from the other things (No movies, secular music, etc.).
- We will respect and pay for any damages to camp property.
- We will not leave the campgrounds or skip any activities unless permission is granted.
- We will make sure not to have any alcohol, tobacco, or any other illegal substances with us at camp.
- We will not bring any sort of weapons [Ex: any type of guns (including paint ball guns), knives, slingshots or any ninja-type weapons].
- Cell phone use is permitted only during free time.
- Pranks or jokes advocating any sort of ungodly character or attitude are not permissible under any circumstance [(Ex: pretending to get high), (Phil. 4:8)].



## Camp Rules (Page 2)

- 1) All campers must adhere and obey the camp rules.
  - Failure to do so will result in a one-on-one meeting with the leaders and proper steps will be taken from there.
  - If camper's behavior becomes a constant issue at camp and problem for others, the camper who is exhibiting this behavior will be sent home immediately.
  
- 2) All campers must attend the camp activities that are planned out for the entire group (announcements will be made as to which these activities are).
  - If camper is sick or injured, he/she may be excused from participating in an activity. Please notify a leader so they can help you out
  - A camper may refuse to participate in a particular activity if there are options available to choose from.
  - Failure to participate in an activity because of no desire will result in a camp punishment, chosen from below by one of the camp leaders:
    - ❖ Cleaning the guy or girl bathrooms before going to bed and the next morning also
    - ❖ Cleaning the cafeteria tables/floor for all meals of the day (breakfast, lunch, and dinner)
  - Failure to comply with any of the above deserved punishments will result in suspension from camp of the camper.
  
- 3) Both RBYA rules and Camp Laurelville rules are to be upheld by both leaders and campers.
  - Failure to obey any of these rules will result in either a camp punishment or a one-on-one meeting with the leaders to decide upon a solution
  - Failure to comply with rules/leaders in order to change the problem will result in suspension from camp of the camper
